Tableau 9.2 Upgrade

This January we successfully completed upgrading our Tableau Shared Server environment to version 9.2. At this time users can publish to the new environment using Tableau Desktop 9.2. If you have a Tableau Desktop license we advise you to download the latest version from our <u>Software Library</u>.

When you register your Tableau Desktop License it captures your machine name. In the event that you are switching departments or obtaining a new machine, it is imperative that you deactivate the key before you surrender your computer. This way when you receive your new machine you can download the software from our Software Library and activate your key. We have had several people replace their computer or leave the University without deactivating their key. This makes it more difficult to reclaim the key through the vendor. Are you receiving Pop-ups to update Tableau Desktop?

If you downloaded Tableau from the software library you are probably not receiving these messages. However, if you are we would prefer that you turn off this feature. In Tableau desktop navigate to Help> Settings and Performance and select "Disable Automatic Product Updates". Remember it is important that you stay on version 9.2 to be consistent with our server. As long as you are using a 9.2.X version you can publish workbooks to the server. However, if you upgraded to 9.3 which is currently a beta version you will run into an issue. You will have to uninstall and download the correct version from the <u>Software Library</u>. If you have any questions regarding this, please contact us for help.
