Unexpected Error

By any chance have you received an Unexpected Error message when accessing a workbook on the Tableau server when using Chrome as your browser? It reads," An unexpected error occurred. If you continue to receive this error, please contact your Tableau Server Administrator." This error has been identified as a known bug running a workbook using Chrome. The workaround at this time is to try and reload the workbook or use a different browser like Firefox or Internet Explorer. We expect that the issue will be resolved in Tableau 9.1 but we are not planning to upgrade the server environment at this time. We know that this can be inconvenient and ask that you please try a different browser.

Microsoft SQL Server Reporting Services (SSRS)

SSRS is another BI tool that enables users to quickly and easily generate reports from Microsoft SQL Server databases. It can be useful for more tabular, operational reporting, or highly formatted reports. We have been in contact with other groups that have used this product. It is another option to help you with your reporting needs. This month we will build out a shared Development environment. We will keep you informed on our progress and when this tool will be available to the community.

ITS Software Library to provide Tableau

We decided to make it easier for the user community to locate the correct version of Tableau Desktop software that runs on our shared server environment. Therefore, we are putting it in the ITS software library. The trial version will be available to anyone that is interested in checking out Tableau. To obtain a license, you will still need to put in a request to bicp@yale.edu. In addition, we are also providing you with a link to a workbook that will provide step by step instructions on how to install the Yale color palette. This will allow report developers to use recommended Yale colors when developing workbooks and dashboards. You can expect to find this available to you by the end of this week. Software Library
