You need to provide your full name, email, location, school, date of birth and upload a supporting documentation showing your current status as a student. Valid documents include a current student ID card, current course schedule, or an official verification document on school letterhead. Documents must include your name and date of validity. It is advised to download the latest ITS supported version from our <u>Software Library</u>. Tableau can help you with research projects and data visualization using its drag-and-drop interface which makes it easier to analyze and present.
